The role of periodontal plastic surgical procedures in the creation and maintenance of soft tissue esthetics (e.g., papillae) is becoming increasingly important in today's overall periodontal/implant therapy. This course is not only designed to help dentists to incorporate the techniques or materials that have been successful used in managing soft tissue around natural teeth/dental implants. At the end of the program each participant will:

- ◆ recognize esthetic smile components (such as the correct incisal edge; symmetrical gingival tissues; the "Golden proportion"; the ideal width/length ratio; the anticipated inclination)
- ◆ understand the principle of periodontal plastic surgery
- ◆ know the anatomy associated with soft tissue grafting
- ◆ learn how to use different instruments to accomplish the therapeutic goals
- ◆ know factors involved in the management of recession (soft tissue) defects
- ◆ learn step-by-step surgical sequence and clinical tips associated with coronally advanced flap, free soft tissue grafts, subepithelial connective tissue grafts, collagen membranes, and acellular dermal matrix
- ◆ learn the advantages and limitations associated with above procedures
- ◆ know the effect of promoting agents (e.g., platelet rich plasma, enamel matrix protein) and cell seeding (e.g., tissue engineering)
